# **Grooming Area**

The Gateway Hall is a 13,500-square-foot space for benching and grooming, and features easy access to the dog bathing room and handler changing rooms.

All **dogs MUST be removed** from the crating area each day unless you have made arrangements and paid the fee to leave the dogs overnight. Grooming will be in designated areas only. Grooming/Crating area will be available Tuesday, March 18, 2025 at 2:00 p.m.

**There is no charge for grooming but dogs left in the building overnight will be charged a fee of \$45.00 per owner per night.**

It is also expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the Purina Grounds.

No exercise pens allowed in the grooming area.

**ALL CRATES IN GROOMING AREA MUST DISPLAY  
CELL PHONE NUMBER AND NAME OF RESPONSIBLE PARTY.**

**\$45.00/per owner/per night charge to leave dogs overnight in Grooming area.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccination records on hand.

**Building will be locked from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.**

### **Head Type Male**

The Head type class is open to any dog age twelve months or older. This class should only be judged on the Head piece of the entry per the Breed Standard. Head type is broken down by breed and sex. 1st—3rd place will be awarded to dogs that head most correctly fits the breed standard for that breed and sex.

### **Head Type Female**

The Head type class is open to any bitch age twelve month or older. This class should only be judged on the Head piece of the entry per the Breed Standard. Head type is broken down by breed and sex. 1st thru 3rd place will be awarded to dogs that head most correctly fits the breed standard for that breed and sex.

### **Movement**

The movement class is open to any dog age twelve months or older. This class should only be judged on the movement of the entry per the Breed Standard. Movement is not broken down by sex but by breed. Movements should be the same per Breed Standard for males and females. 1st thru 3rd will be awarded to the dogs in each breed that exhibit correct movement per the breed standard for that breed.

**Head Type and Movement will show at different times to be judged and will be separated by Breed**

### **Breeders Showcase**

Combination of three (3) dogs entered as one entry to highlight breeder's program. Breed must be in the ring. This class is not to be judged as individuals, but as the overall quality represented by a breeder. All must be judged against the Breed Standard for uniformity. **Only one entry per Breeder.**

### **Generations**

Minimum of three (3), maximum of five (5) consecutive generations to be judged against the Breed Standard with consistency within the group with an eye for each generation being closer to the Breed Standard.

Example of Generations—Grandparent, Parent, Child, Etc.

**Only one entry per breeder.**

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). The staging area will include a warm-up and waiting area as well as the secretary's table for check-ins and posting of running order and results. The Handlers' Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handlers' Briefing, the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, the number of hides, maximum height of hides, and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handlers' Briefing.

### **Non-Competitive Junior Showmanship**

This class is for Juniors 0-12 years of age. As long as the junior can walk while assisted, and can hold the leash they can participate in this class. All Juniors participating in this class will receive a trophy, donated by Ray and Peri Ann Williams of Saddlebag Aussies. Juniors are not placed and will be asked to move their dogs, show them on the ground or grooming table (depending on the dogs breed). Parents can assist this junior in this class if they need it.

### **12 and under Competitive Junior Showmanship**

This Class is for Juniors Ages 4-12 (as of January 1). Juniors in this class will be ranked 1st - 3rd place (if more than 3 some juniors will not place and receive an award). Judges will ask juniors to move their dogs, stack them on the table/ground, show their bites, ask anatomy questions, ask for specific patterns while moving the dog (L, Down and Back, Triangle, Ect.), and breed related questions to rank the juniors from most knowledgeable, to least knowledgeable handler.

### **13-18 Competitive Junior Showmanship**

This Class is for Juniors Ages 13 - 18 (as of January 1). Juniors in this class will be ranked 1st - 3rd place (if more than 3 some juniors will not place and receive an award). Judges will ask juniors to move their dogs, stack them on the table/ground, show their bites, ask anatomy questions, ask for specific patterns while moving the dog (L, Down and Back, Triangle, Ect.), and breed related questions to rank the juniors from most knowledgeable, to least knowledgeable handler.


