# Grooming Area

The Gateway Hall is a 13,500-square-foot space for benching and grooming, and features easy access to the dog bathing room and handler changing rooms.

All **dogs MUST be removed** from the crating area immediately after the conclusion of judging each day unless you have made arrangements and paid the fee to leave the dogs overnight. Grooming will be in designated areas only. Grooming/Crating area will be available Tuesday, March 12, 2024 at 8:00 a.m.

**There is no charge for grooming but dogs left in the building overnight will be charge a fee of \$35.00 per owner per night.** [Click here to sign up](#)

It is also expressly understood that every dog at the show is in the care, custody and control of its owner or handler during the time the dog is on the Purina Grounds.

No exercise pens allowed in the grooming area.

**ALL CRATES IN GROOMING AREA MUST DISPLAY**

**\$35.00/per owner/per night charge to leave dogs overnight in Grooming area.**

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccination records on hand.

**Building will be locked from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m.**

## **Puppy Sweepstakes**

**Eligibility:** This Puppy Sweepstakes is open to any breed that is registered by American Stock Dog Registry that are at least three months on the day of the show but not more than twelve months.

The six male class winners will compete for Best Male and the six female class winners will compete for Best Female. Best Male will compete against Best Female for Best of Breed.

Best of Breed for each of the Breeds represented will compete for Best in Sweeps Puppy and Reserve Best in Sweeps Puppy.

This will be payout only. Titles can be earned but there will be no critiques. Placements will count toward Top Ten if an exhibitor pays the money and nominates their dog for Top Ten.

The payout for each class will be figured using the formulas on Page 6. The following classes will be provided for dogs and bitches:

3 Months & Under 6 Months	3 Months and Under 6 Months BBX
6 Months & Under 9 Months	6 Months & Under 9 Months BBX
9 Months & Under 12 Months	9 Months & Under 12 Months BBX

## **Adult Sweepstakes**

**Eligibility:** This Adult Sweepstakes is open to any breed that is registered by American Stock Dog Registry that are at least twelve months and not more than six years old and unaltered.

The six male class winners will compete for Best Male and the six female class winners will compete for Best Female. Best Male will compete against Best Female for Best of Breed and Reserve Best of Breed.

Best of Breed for each of the breeds represented will compete for Best in Sweepstakes Adult and Reserve Best in Sweeps Adult.

This will be payout only. Titles can be earned but there will be no critiques or awards. Placements will count toward Top Ten if an exhibitor pays the money and nominates their dog for Top Ten. The following classes will be offered for dogs and bitches:

Twelve Months to 18 Months	Twelve Months to 18 Months BBX
18 Months to under 36 Months	18 Months to under 36 Months BBX
36 months to under 6 years	36 months to under 6 years BBX
Champion Class	Champion Class BBX

### **Head Type Male**

The Head type class is open to any dog age twelve months or older. This class should only be judged on the Head piece of the entry per the Breed Standard. Head type is broken down by breed and sex. 1st—3rd place will be awarded to dogs that head most correctly fits the breed standard for that breed and sex.

### **Head Type Female**

The Head type class is open to any bitch age twelve month or older. This class should only be judged on the Head piece of the entry per the Breed Standard. Head type is broken down by breed and sex. 1st thru 3rd place will be awarded to dogs that head most correctly fits the breed standard for that breed and sex.

### **Movement**

The movement class is open to any dog age twelve months or older. This class should only be judged on the movement of the entry per the Breed Standard. Movement is not broken down by sex but by breed. Movements should be the same per Breed Standard for males and females. 1st thru 3rd will be awarded to the dogs in each breed that exhibit correct movement per the breed standard for that breed.

**Head Type and Movement will show at different times to be judged and will be separated by Breed**

### **Breeders Showcase**

Combination of three (3) dogs entered as one entry to highlight breeder's program. Breed must be in the ring. This class is not to be judged as individuals, but as the overall quality represented by a breeder. All must be judged against the Breed Standard for uniformity. **Only one entry per Breeder.**

### **Generations**

Minimum of three (3), maximum of five (5) consecutive generations to be judged against the Breed Standard with consistency within the group with an eye for each generation being closer to the Breed Standard.

Example of Generations—Grandparent, Parent, Child, Etc.

**Only one entry per breeder.**

## **Veteran Sweepstakes**

**Eligibility:** This Veteran Sweepstakes is open to any breed that is registered by American Stock Dog Registry that are at least six years old and unaltered.

Best of Breed for each of the Breeds represented will compete in Best in Sweeps Veteran and Reserve Best in Sweeps Veteran.

This will be payout only. Titles can be earned but there will be no critiques or awards. Placements will count toward Top Ten if an exhibitor pays the money and nominates their dog for Top Ten.

The payout for each class will be figured using the formulas below.

## **Altered Sweepstakes**

**Eligibility:** This Altered Sweepstakes is open to any breed that is registered by American Stock Dog Registry that are altered. Altered is defined as being spayed or neutered. Best of Breed and Reserve Best of Breed will be awarded.

This will be payout only. Titles can be earned but there will be no critiques or awards. Placements will count toward Top Ten if an exhibitor pays the money and nominates their dog for Top Ten. Monies will be paid out using formula below:

Best of Breed for each of the breeds represented will compete for Best in Sweepstakes Altered and Reserve Best in Sweepstakes Altered.

## **Sweepstakes Prizes**

Sweepstakes Entry Fees will be divided as follows: Thirty Five percent (35%) of total entry fees will be retained by the American Stock Dog Registry for expenses:

The remaining 65% will be divided as follows: First—40%, Second 30%, Third 20%.

The remaining 10% goes into the Purse for payout to Best in Show and Reserve Best In Show.

Example—3-6 month male class has 6 entries @ \$35.00 each

Total Entry Fees = \$210.00

Club keeps 35% or \$73.50 remaining \$136.50 is paid out as follows:

1st place receives \$54.60

2nd place receives \$40.95

3rd place receives \$27.30

The remaining 10% will go into the Prize Purse for Best in Sweepstakes and Reserve Best in Sweepstakes which will be divided 60/40. If a class has less than three exhibitors, the pay out will remain the same percentages as above with the places not paid out going into the Prize Purse for Best in Sweepstakes.

The Handlers' Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handlers' Briefing, the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, the number of hides, maximum height of hides, and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handlers' Briefing.

### **Non-Competitive Junior showmanship:**

This class is for Juniors 0-12 years of age. As long as the junior can walk while assisted, and can hold the leash they can participate in this class. All Juniors participating in this class will receive a trophy, donated by Ray and Peri Ann Williams of Saddlebag Aussies. Juniors are not placed and will be asked to move their dogs, show them on the ground or grooming table (depending on the dogs breed). Parents can assist this junior in this class if they need it.

### **12 and under Competitive Junior Showmanship:**

This Class is for Juniors Ages 4-12 (as of January 1). Juniors in this class will be ranked 1st - 3rd place (if more than 3 some juniors will not place and receive an award). Judges will ask juniors to move their dogs, stack them on the table/ground, show their bites, ask anatomy questions, ask for specific patterns while moving the dog (L, Down and Back, Triangle, Ect.), and breed related questions to rank the juniors from most knowledgeable, to least knowledgeable handler.

### **13-18 Competitive Junior Showmanship:**

This Class is for Juniors Ages 13 - 18 (as of January 1). Juniors in this class will be ranked 1st - 3rd place (if more than 3 some juniors will not place and receive an award). Judges will ask juniors to move their dogs, stack them on the table/ground, show their bites, ask anatomy questions, ask for specific patterns while moving the dog (L, Down and Back, Triangle, Ect.), and breed related questions to rank the juniors from most knowledgeable, to least knowledgeable handler.

## **Purina Farms Overnight Camping Reservation Request Form**

Thank you for requesting an overnight camping space in one of the Purina Farms designated RV lots. Our RV Engagement Specialist will respond back to your reservation request within 5-7 business days to let you know whether your reservation is confirmed. Reservations are taken on a first-come; first-served basis and are assigned based on length of equipment (rig) and space availability. If confirmed, you will receive an emailed confirmation and instructions on how to pay for your space. Full payment must be received before the space can be confirmed and finalized.

Purina Farms offers 2 different RV lots on property. The Full Service Purina Event Center RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric, water and sewer. The Electric Only Main Show Field RV lot offers 30 and 50 amp electric.

Any RVs bigger than 50' must reserve a spot in the full-service Purina Event Center lot. Max size of RV on property is 55'. Tow vehicles are not factored into the length of the spaces as they must be unhooked.

**Spaces are refundable if cancelled more than 3 days out from the arrival date listed on the reservation confirmation. Otherwise, no refunds will be given. Spaces are non-transferable.**

Please note that RV reservations are only accepted for those entered (or those who have dogs/cats entered) in an event that has contracted space, which includes the overnight camping lots.

The Purina Farms RV lots are only open to vehicles specifically designed with overnight sleeping accommodations including motorhomes, fifth wheels and travel trailers.

Quiet time in the RV area is from 11:00PM to 6:00AM.

**If you have an RV rental, you must ensure that the RV is dropped off and picked up in accordance with your reservation dates and times. Plan accordingly with the supplier.**
